	 a. Please make sure to always follow your approved coursework form. Once you are admitted to the M.Ed program, you will update and submit your initial coursework form to the Program Director in November and April of each year.
	b. Pre-approval from the Program Director is needed for registration for electives. Preapproval occurs in November and April when you update and submit your coursework form.
	c. ED PS 6728 Reading & Literacy Comprehensive Review and Exam Prep is taken with your comprehensive exam. It is offered every Spring semester. Pre-approval for this 3-credit comprehensive review and exam class is needed from the Program Director and occurs when you update and submit your coursework form in November and April.
	d. This projected schedule only lists courses offered by the Reading and Literacy Program in the Department of Educational Psychology. Many of the elective choices are not in the Reading and Literacy program. You will need to check the U of U Course Schedule and the U of U Reading Clinic websites to find if a particular elective is offered the semester you wish to take
