To Faculty Advisor: The faculty advisor is responsible for initial approval of all course syllabi; please consult with current course instructor when it is not clear that the course for which waiver is sought is comparable to the one already taken by the student. Courses such as statistics, research design, and professional issues and ethics are typically not comparable, as they are usually taught with different content and/or difficulty at the master's and PhD levels. Of special note:

- Ethics courses must have had a primary focus on APA Code of Ethics and legal issues related to psychologists.
- EDPS 6710, Practicum in Counseling, is not automatically waived using this application process.
- EDPS 7710, Practicum in Counseling Psychology (Core Practicum), is never waived.
- EDPS 7200, Foundations of Counseling Psychology, is never waived
